

Rules for Using Storage Facilities at Warsaw University of Technology Student Dormitories

§ 1

1. These rules define the principles for the use of storage rooms, hereinafter referred to as “Storage Facilities,” by residents of the Student Dormitory, hereinafter referred to as “DS,” located within the respective DS.
2. Each person using the Storage Facility, hereinafter referred to as the “User,” is obligated to comply with these rules.
3. Storage Facilities are available exclusively to residents of the DS where the facility is located.
4. The Dormitory Council of Residents of the respective DS, hereinafter referred to as “CR,” appoints a Storage Facility Supervisor, hereinafter referred to as the “Supervisor,” responsible for managing access to the facility. If no Supervisor is appointed, the chairperson of the CR assumes this role.
5. Warsaw University of Technology is not responsible for any damage to or loss of stored items.
6. The term “Action” refers to the period during which the Supervisor allows residents access to the Storage Facility under the conditions specified in these rules.

§ 2

1. The Supervisor informs DS residents about Action schedules via CR social media and notices posted on the CR information board.
2. Action schedules may be subject to change, and updates will be communicated as outlined in item 1.
3. Items may be stored for a maximum of one year. The Supervisor, in consultation with the CR, may set different terms and will announce any changes alongside Action schedules.
4. Access to the Storage Facility is granted exclusively by the Supervisor.
5. The Supervisor may appoint a deputy if needed, notifying the DS Administrator.
6. At residents' request, the Supervisor may organize ad-hoc Actions.

§ 3

1. The Supervisor must conduct a storage Action in June, selecting dates that are as convenient as possible for DS residents.
2. Items stored in the Storage Facility must be properly packaged or secured to minimize the risk of damage if relocation is necessary.
3. Each item must be labeled with the User’s details in a durable manner, including:
 - 1) Full name;
 - 2) Current room number (and the new room number for the next housing period, if applicable);
 - 3) Phone number;
 - 4) Email address (preferably in the pw.edu.pl domain);
 - 5) Date of deposit;
 - 6) Item number and the total number of stored items.
4. Storing items listed in the declaration attached to these rules is prohibited.
5. The User’s declaration of compliance with item 4 is included in the appendix to these rules and must be signed and submitted to the Supervisor.
6. In case of property damage caused by a breach of item 4, the User bears financial responsibility.

7. Items without the required labeling (item 3) or an accompanying declaration (item 5) will not be accepted for storage..

§ 4

1. The Supervisor must conduct a retrieval Action in October, selecting dates that are as convenient as possible for DS residents.
2. Items not retrieved within 90 days of the retrieval Action's conclusion or the period specified in §2 item 3 will become the property of the CR or be disposed of.
3. In disputes or matters not covered by these rules, decisions are made by the DS Manager in consultation with the CR..
