

**Schedule accommodation campaign**  
**„Erasmus +, summer semester 2026”**

<b>December 5, 2025</b>	Start of application submission via the ESKS system.
<b>December 17, 2025</b>	End of the application period for the accommodation campaign.
<b>December 18, 2025</b>	Deadline for submitting applications returned for correction due to formal reasons.
<b>December 18, 2025</b>	Final deadline for verification of lists by ISO (confirmation of place).
<b>December 23, 2025</b>	The deadline for assigning dormitory (without specifying the room number) and creating a guarantee fee.
<b>January 6, 2026</b>	The deadline for confirming acceptance of a place by crediting the reservation fee to the appropriate account (indicated in the referral).
<b>February 20, 2026</b>	First day of referral validity (start of the accommodation process for people who have been allocated a place in the campaign).
<b>March 9, 2026</b>	Last day of referral validity (end of the accommodation process for persons who have been allocated a place in the campaign).

## **Regulations of accommodation campaign „Erasmus +, Summer semester 2026**

1. The campaign is open to students admitted for partial studies under the Erasmus+ program starting in the summer semester of 2026 in the recruitment campaign coordinated by the Centre for International Cooperation
2. Places are awarded only to those who correctly complete and submit an application in the ESKS system.
3. Places are granted for the summer semester (20.02.2026 to 30.06.2026).
4. Places are granted according to the period resulting from the nomination from the partner university.
5. Submitted applications must be correct in terms of formal requirements, i.e., they must include all mandatory fields filled in, contain accurate data, particularly the permanent residence address and at least one identity document number (ID card number or passport number).
6. Places are granted on a first-come, first-served basis.
7. Only those who have not been punished with disciplinary penalties during their accommodation in the dormitories of Warsaw University of Technology may take part in the campaign.
8. Only those who, as of the date of the creation of the guarantee fee, will be settled with the dormitories, i.e. have no outstanding payments, can participate in the campaign. Persons who do not live in WUT dormitories at the time of application, but lived previously, must have a “settled” status.
9. The preferred dormitory selected in the application is only a hint to the accommodation committee. Selecting it does not guarantee receiving a place in it.
10. Those who receive a place in the WUT dormitories will have to pay a guarantee fee of 500 PLN to the account number indicated in the referral.
11. The guarantee fee must be credited to the account indicated in the order within a maximum of 14 days after its issuance.
12. Not paying the guarantee fee in the required amount and deadline is equivalent to resignation from the assigned place.
13. In the case of a guarantee fee of more than the fixed PLN 500, the overpayment will be credited to the first months accommodation fees.
14. Certificates for allocation of accommodation will be issued only after payment of the guarantee fee.
15. In case of resignation after payment of the guarantee fee, the fee is non-refundable.

16. Referrals issued as part of the campaign will be valid from February 20 to March 9, 2026. Failure to check in during this period will result in the loss of the allocated place and guarantee fee.
